Bus Service Agreement

The Academy is pleased to provide transportation between campuses for our students and solicits parent assistance in creating a safe, healthy operation. Because a school bus is an extension of the classroom, The Academy requires children to conduct themselves on the bus in a manner consistent with established behavioral standards agreed to in the Parent/Student Handbook.

The bus driver is responsible for maintaining order on his/her bus. If an incident occurs on the bus, the bus driver will notify the home campus principal. Depending on the severity of the offense, students may receive a warning or may lose the privilege of utilizing The Academy Bus Service. If you should need information concerning student misconduct on buses, contact your student's campus principal.

General Safety Rules

1. Obey the instructions of the bus driver.
2. Only students who have made a reservation to ride may be transported.
3. Leave the bus cleaner than you found it.
4. Follow all school rules.
5. Help look after the safety and comfort of small children.

Loading the Bus

1. Arrive at your bus stop five (5) minutes before scheduled departure. Drivers leave promptly at the scheduled time in order to ensure a timely arrival.
2. Parents are responsible for providing transportation to and from school if a child misses the bus.

Unloading the Bus

1. Stay seated until the bus is completely stopped.
3. Wait for your turn to leave the bus.
4. If any article drops or rolls near, or under, the bus—do not go after it. Go to the door and ask the driver for help.

Supervision

Parents are expected to be present and waiting for the bus when it drops off children in the afternoon. Bus drivers are on a schedule and cannot wait. By using the bus, parents agree to put in place a backup supervision plan in the event they are running late. Academy employees do not provide supervision for students after they are off the bus.

Busing is a privilege, not a right. The Academy reserves the right to discontinue providing bus service to a student in violation of the Bus Service Agreement.

Parents/Guardians understand The Academy requires children to conduct themselves on the bus in a manner consistent with established behavioral standards agreed to in the Parent/Student Handbook. By using transportation provided by The Academy, parents/guardians agree to this Bus Service Agreement.
